2016 FERGALICIOUS

Strong herbal and peppercorn start to the nose of this wine, followed by leather and black fruit. The blend of 40% Syrah, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Petit Verdot and 20% Grenache shows Gamay Old World flavors on the palate of dried leather.

2018 ESTATE SYRAH

Estate grown 2018 Syrah is a slightly riper vintage than previous years. Full of black cherry and blackberry fruit, espresso and spicy notes. This round texture wine and soft tannins will please your palate.

CALLING ALL ANGELS

Fruit-forward, medium-bodied Chardonnay. Fantastic citrus scent & a hint of pineapple that works great with the slight vanilla bean notes.



SOUL SISTER

This Pinot Noir is an expressive, medium ruby wine with flavors of ripe cherries and strawberries, a hint of vanilla and a smooth finish!

DROPS OF JUPITER

Fruit-forward, insanely loveable Petite Sirah- based Red Wine. The minute you uncork the bottle, the boysenberry fruit leaps from your glass.

DOJ PINOT NOIR

Alluring aromas of cherry fruit leather, cream soda, and soft herbs rise from the glass. Soft, supple flavors of raspberry coulis, strawberry rhubarb pastry, and smashed blackberries meets subtle undertones of earthy mushroom on the palate. Soft and soothing on the finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

This sophisticated, full-bodied cabernet sauvignon has layers of dark fruits, cherry, and balanced tannins that create a rich and long finish. Integrated vanilla and warm toasty notes come from 14 months of aging in premium French and American oak barrels.





2019 ROSE

This dry California Rosé is a soft light pink in color with delicate floral and tropical aromas. Crisp and light in body with fresh, fruity flavors of watermelon, strawberry, and nectarine.

2018 CHARDONNAY

Pale straw in color with flavors of nectarine, baked apple, and nice toasted marshmallow notes. Rich and fruity upfront, finishing crisp & elegant. This is well-balanced, medium-bodied wine is a great example of what can be done with this varietal on the Central Coast.

CRUSH RED BLEND

This wine brings juicy red fruit with good mid-palate weight from the Merlot, ripe, jammy flavors from the Zinfandel, and dark fruit and structure from the Petite Sirah and Tannat. This blend of the California's finest varieties results in a very tasty, complex wine with lots of fruit flavors and a long, soft finish.

2020 PINOT NOIR

2020 PROPRIETARY RED BLEND

Dark garnet in the glass, commanding aromas of blueberry, caramel and toasted oak preview a bold, mouth-filling palate stacked with concentrated layers of ripe dark fruit, black cherry and milk chocolate. Robust and full-bodied with excellent weight in the mid-palate, this complex wine leaves a lasting impression with a smooth, round and full finish.



2020 SAUVIGNON BLANC

Bright aromas of lemongrass, melon, and guava. On the palate, tropical flavors of passion fruit and mango are accented by zesty lemon, lime and orange blossom. Refreshing and balanced, this medium-bodied Sauvignon Blanc extends into a juicy, lingering finish.





SISTER MOON

Named after Sting's song "Sister Moon" this was the first IGT Toscana wine produced at Il Palagio. With an alcohol content of 14.9% it is aged for 24 months in new French barriques. Aromas Sweet cherries, crushed flowers and licorice.

WHEN WE DANCE

This charming every day chianti is again named after a Sting song – When We Dance. With 95% Sangiovese blended with Canaiolo and Colorino grapes, the alcohol content is 13%. When We Dance is a glorious ruby red colour and has a palate that is balanced and smooth.

Delicate profile, floral with notes of citrus, a hint of pineapple and banana. Fresh taste, pleasantly acidic with a long finish.





LVE French Sparkling Rosé

The pink color of our LVE Rosé French Sparkling is reminiscent of a vineyard peach. With a fruity nose, blending notes of citrus and small red fruits, the bubbles are soft and pleasant. 
The "Rock Blocks"







Look at the wine. Notice if the wine is clear and brilliant or cloudy and dull. A wine's color is better judged by putting it against a white background. Colors give the taster clues to the grape variety, and whether the wine was aged in wood. Typically, wine that had been oak aged is darker in color. As a general rule, color saturation tends to go hand in hand with flavor intensity.

Smell

Smell is the main sense used in wine tasting, so sniffing the wine before tasting is essential. A wine's quality can be judged by its nose and taste. Consider what you are smelling. What does the aroma remind you of? Fruits or vegetables? Herbs or spices?

Savor

The finish is the sensation you get from actually swallowing the wine and it can be very different from the taste you get on your palate. What you want to look for is an alcohol taste and the length of time the wine taste stays with you. This length of time is called the finish and some wines can linger for as long as a minute.

Swirl

Swirl the wine a couple times. Heavy wines will be deeper in color and generally more intense on the nose. Sweeter wines, being denser will leave thick, viscous streaks (called legs) down the inside of the glass when swirled.

Sip

Take a slightly larger sip than usual and hold the wine in your mouth for 3-5 seconds letting it coat the surface. It is here that the complex taste experience and characteristics of a wine actually happen. Look for sweetness, fruitiness, saltiness, acidity, bitterness, and alcohol. What's your overall impression? Does any component overpower the others or is the wine balanced?
